Among over 24,000 organizations which disclosed information through CDP's platform in 2023, our initiatives received high praise and we were selected as one of the "A List" companies.

•Meiji Yasuda's initiatives to address climate change

As part of our activities to address climate change, we set a target of net-zero CO2 emissions to be achieved in FY2050 and an intermediate target to be achieved in FY2030 and formulated the "Roadmap for Net-zero CO2 Emissions" from the standpoint of both a business operator and an institutional investor.

As a business operator, we strive for the introduction of renewable energies and promotion of energy conservation, including the use of more efficient air conditioning equipment. We are also promoting the reduction of emissions throughout the entire supply chain via, for example, the introduction of digitized procedures for paperless operations and the pursuit of more efficient logistics. As an institutional investor, we invest and finance in green bonds and renewable energy generation projects, setting "Decarbonization" as one of the priority themes for ESG investment and financing, and also we actively promote decarbonization through engagement with investee companies.

We will continue to contribute to the creation of a sustainable and hopeful society including the realization of a carbon-free society.
