Completion of Transfer of Shares of Warta and TU Europa (Polish Insurance Companies)

Meiji Yasuda Life Insurance Company (Hideki Nagashima, President and Group CEO) would like to announce that, as previously disclosed on December 23, 2024, regarding the termination of the strategic partnership agreement with Talanx AG (headquartered in Hannover, Germany, "Talanx") and the transfer of shares of Warta Group (headquartered in Warsaw, Poland, "Warta") and Europa Group (headquartered in Wroclaw, Poland, "TU Europa"), the transfer of shares of Warta and TU Europa to Talanx has now been completed in accordance with the agreed terms.

Currently, Meiji Yasuda conducts international insurance businesses in USA, China, and Thailand. We will continue to strengthen and promote our endeavors of international business from the perspective of our group's continued growth and diversification of our business portfolio, in addition to keeping and expanding our strong business foundation in Japanese life insurance market.
