

Group Environmental Policy

Under the management philosophy of “Peace of mind, forever”, Meiji Yasuda Life Insurance Company (the “Company”) sets the Group Environmental Policy that, along with shared values, guides the Meiji Yasuda Group (the “Group”). The Company as well as its subsidiaries and affiliates considers the preservation of the Earth on which people can live with peace of mind to be a universal and crucial issue for humanity. Based on this recognition, we will contribute to the realization of a sustainable society as companies which address climate change issues and value coexistence with nature.

1. Initiatives through Business Activities

(1) Climate Change Measures

We recognize that the increase in abnormal weather and natural disasters caused by global warming is one of the important and urgent issues that can greatly affect people's lives, business activities, and financial stability.

Based on this recognition, we will promote initiatives to support the goal of limiting the rise in global average temperature through the provision of products and services, as well as through investment and financing.

(2) Coexistence with Nature

Through the provision of products and services, as well as investment and financing, we will contribute to the conservation of forests, water resources, and biodiversity, and the transition to a circular economy, etc.

2. Initiatives to Reduce the Company's Environmental Impact and Promote Environmental Awareness

To reduce the Company's environmental impact, we strive to use resources and energy efficiently through promoting resource and energy conservation, recycling of resources, and the purchase of environmentally friendly products.

The Company will make this policy public and promote dialogue, cooperation, and collaboration with various stakeholders such as customers, suppliers, and local communities.

Additionally, we will actively support and participate in international agreements and initiatives related to the environment where consistent with the regulatory and government conditions within which the group and our subsidiaries operate, and while respecting our primary responsibility to policyholders.
